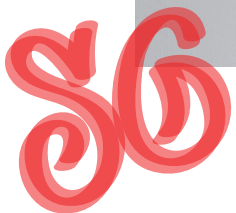
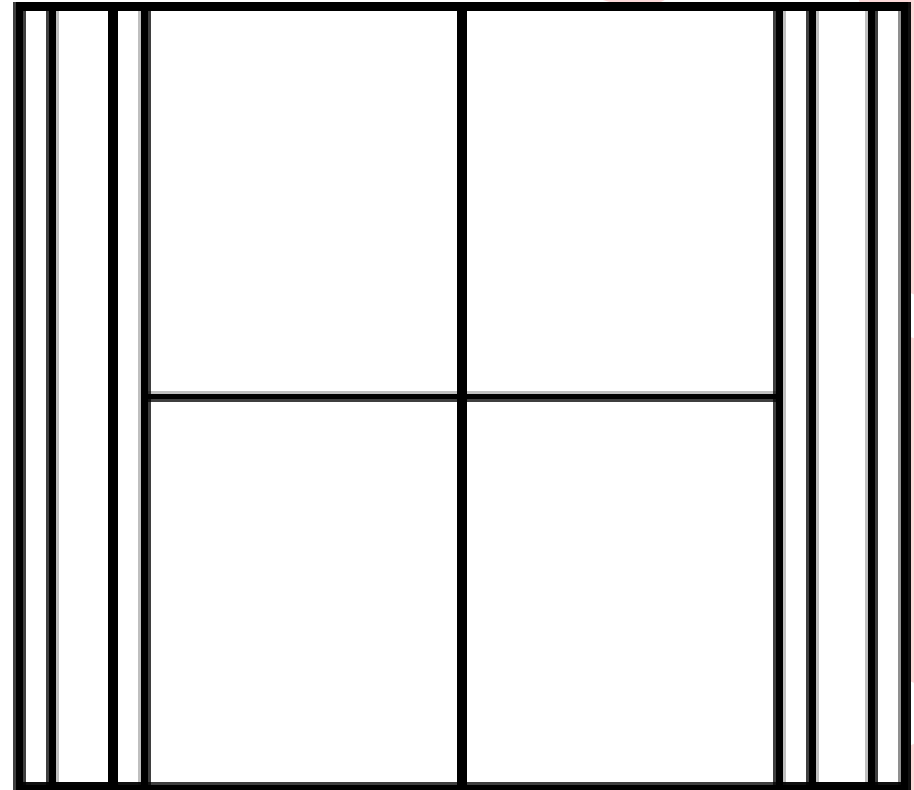


# TODD JAMES

This is an imaginary version of a bedroom by a Graffiti artist called Todd James. Look at all the bright colours and shapes.

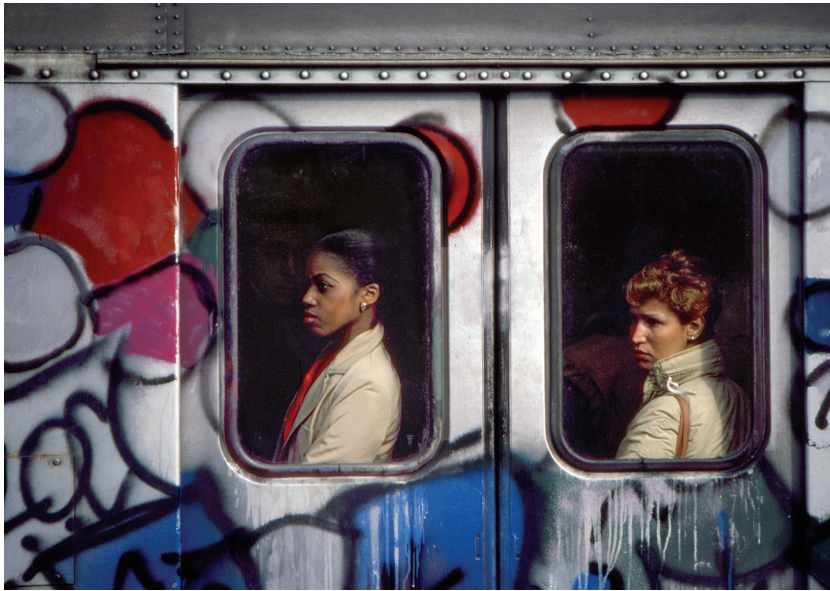


If you had an imaginary room what would you put in it?

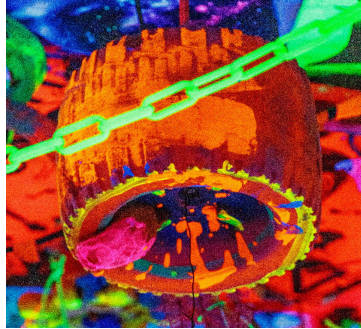
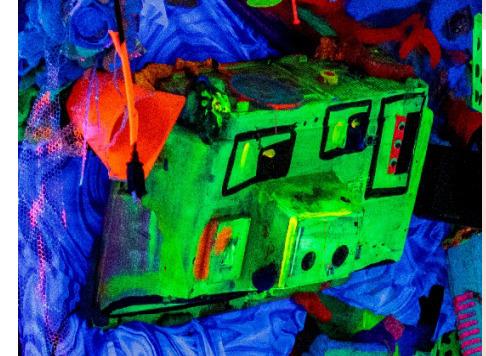
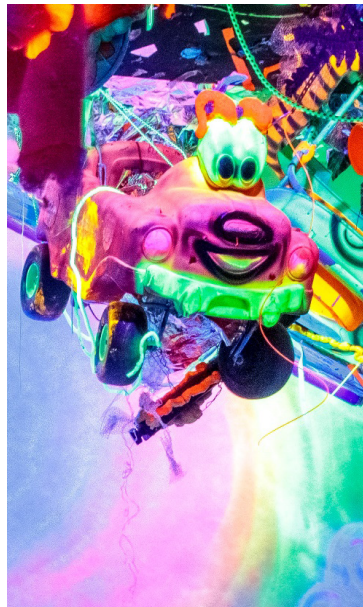
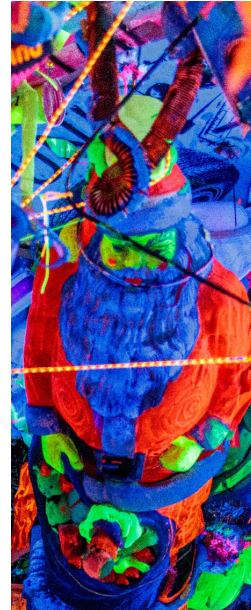
**Henry Chalfant used to graffiti on the side of trains!**

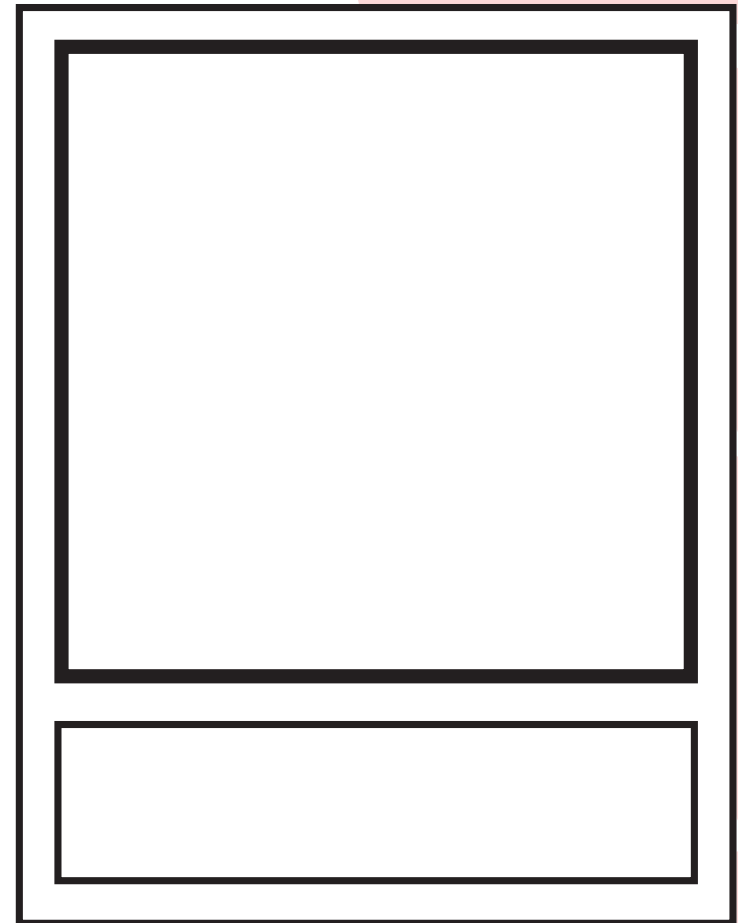
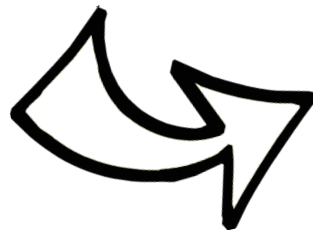


# SHEPARD FAIREY

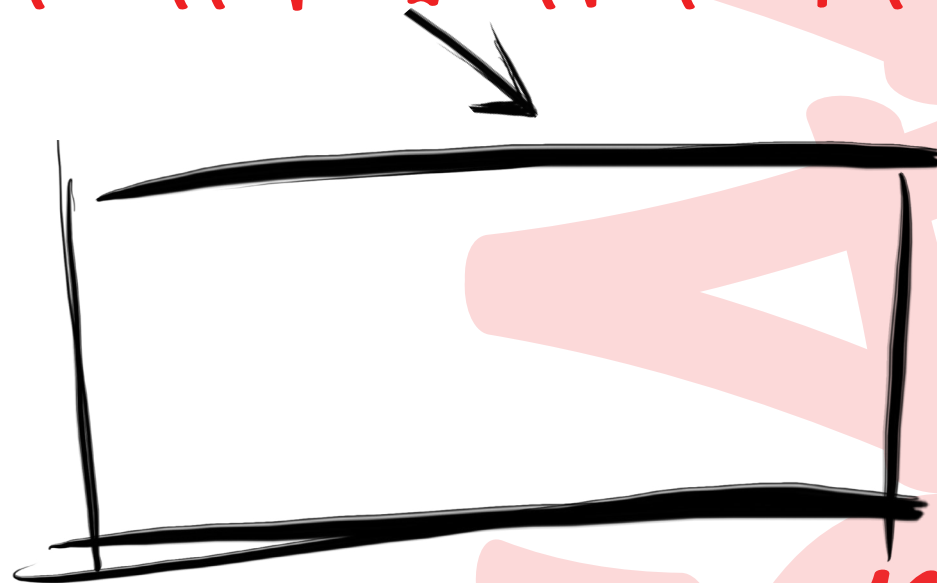
WORDS THAT STAND OUT
